## FAQ - Distinctive ring what happens after an update

## Introduction

Here we would like to describe what happens when you update from an software < 2.26 to software 2.26.x or higher.

You need to take some actions to use the new functionality.

In software < 2.26, the system supports 2 ringtones.

- Internal (Only played when the Alert-Info header in the SIP Invite is recognized "ale rt-internal")
- 2. External (Played in all other cases.)

After the update to the software that supports the new ringtones the following happens.

- The DECT handsets will show the ringtones from the older software and not the new ringtones, but it will use the new ringtones.
  - In the example, Handset 1 will show the **Dunken** ringtone but plays the **Call** 1 tone
  - O Handset 2 will show 07 Super 4 but plays the 09 Tone One

The following solutions are possible.

- Disable the new distinctive ring feature and it will work like before using the 2 ringtones (Internal and External)
- Re-register your DECT handset and then the new ringtones are visible. Reregistration can be done:
  - a. Manual re-registration
  - b. Automatic re-registration (New in 2.29.0)



The DECT handset menu is transferred during the DECT registration process. With the new distinctive ring feature, the DECT handset menu is changed but you will only see this when the DECT handset is new registered. Therefore new DECT registration is needed.
