General info:

A message-waiting indicator (MWI), is a term for a feature that illuminates an LED on a device to notify the user of waiting messages.

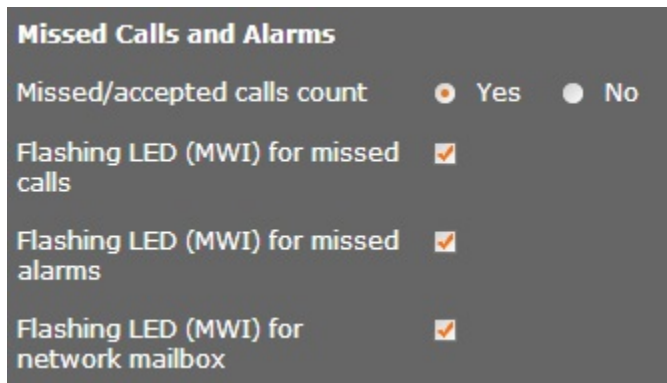
The Gigaset devices support the following MWI indications.
