

Interoperability SL750H PRO - Bluetooth Headsets

Bluetooth headsets

Following Bluetooth headsets have been tested. Remarks show special behaviour or restrictions.

Manufacturer	Model	Remark
Jabra	Wave	No PIN editor, headset does not support re-establishing connection.
Jabra	Easy GO	Headset remembers paired phone, but to re-establish connection, it needs to be switched to pairing mode.
Jabra	Style	Multiple service device (headset + data device). It means that it appears two times on handset "Known Devices" list.
Jabra	Supreme UC	Multiple service device (headset + data device). It means that it appears two times on handset "Known Devices" list. Headset remembers paired phone, but to re-establish connection, it needs to be switched to pairing mode.
Plantronics	Marque2 (M_165)	After 90 min. OFF there will be no re-connection. No PIN editor, headset does not support re-establishing connection.
Plantronics	Voyager Legend	Switching speech path: via putting headset close to the ear (sensor). Headset remembers paired phone, but to re-establish connection, it needs to be switched to pairing mode.
Plantronics	M55	If user deletes device from "Known Device" list, a new manual pairing will be needed.
Plantronics	ML20	No PIN editor, headset does not support re-establishing connection.
Samsung	HM1700	Headset remembers paired phone, but to re-establish connection, it needs to be switched to pairing mode.
Jabra	Style	Multiple Service device (headset + data device). It means that it appears two times on handsets "Known Devices" list.
Sennheiser	EZX80	Headset remembers paired phone, but to re-establish connection, it needs to be switched to pairing mode.
