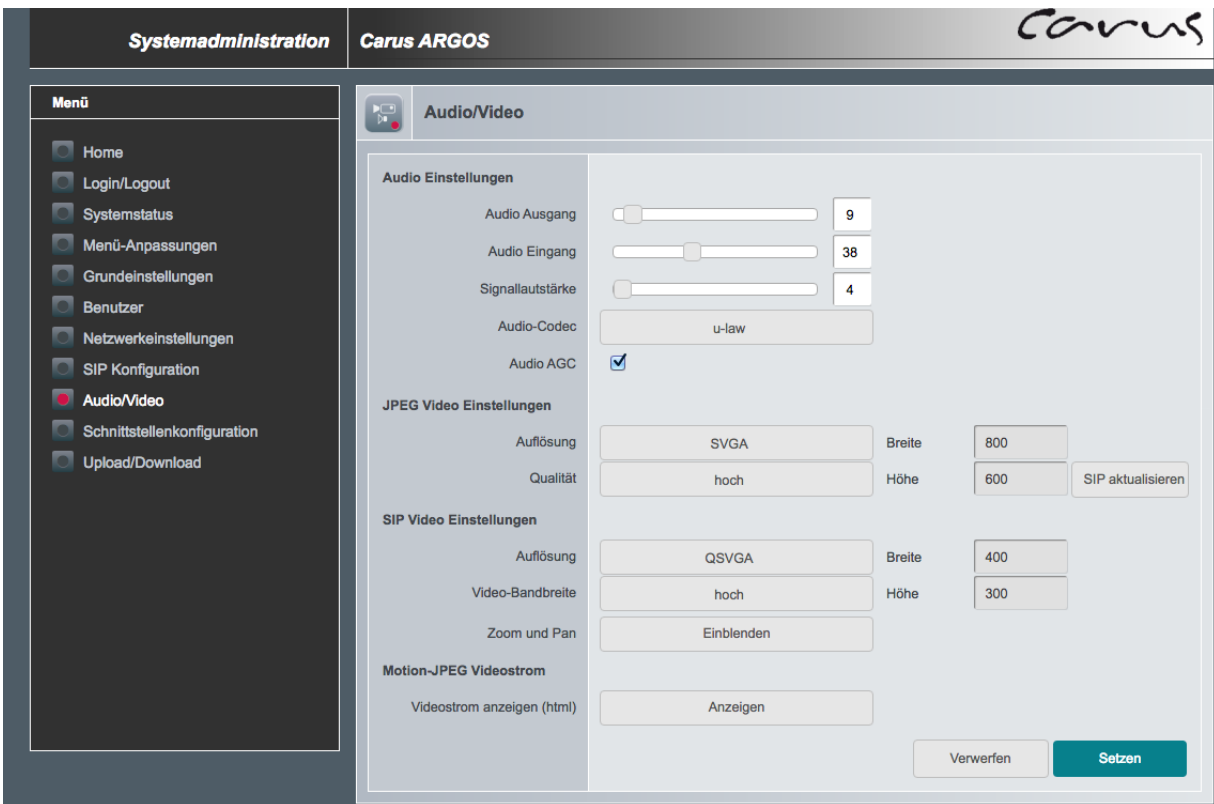

## Maxwell 10 Configuration

In the web-interface of the Maxwell 10 go to: **Settings - Services - Door Interphone**

Door Interphone					
Enter name and SIP ID for door interphone. Enter DTMF code for automatic door opener. Enter IP address of door camera (URL) and reload rate (ms, minimum: 200 ms).

- Enter a name and the SIP ID for the camera.
- Enter the code for the door opener in the DTMF code field. This DTMF code is required to operate the door opener from the phone. The DTMF code can be found in the description of your door interphone.
- Enter the URL of the camera in the Camera(URL) field [http://argos\\_ip/video.jpg](http://argos_ip/video.jpg)
- Set how often the image should be refreshed in ms in the Reload rate field (only important for jpeg).
- Click on Add to add a camera to the list.
- Click on Delete if you want to remove a camera from the list.
- Click on Save to save your settings.
