The <html> element indicates the start and end of an XHTML-MP document: It is the root element for all XHTML Family Document Types.

Contents	One <body> element and one <head> element.		
Attributes	attributes	values (Default are bolded)	description
	xmlns	URL	expected value: "http://www.w3.org/1999/xhtml" Though this attribute is needed to build a valid XHTML document, the mechanism behind it is not supported by the Gigaset system (i.e. specific namespaces are not supported)
