

Auto provisioning: <VERSION> and <MAC_ADDRESS> parameters are not required

Introduction

When using **plain XML** Auto provisioning, the config file will contain the parameters:

```
<MAC_ADDRESS value="7C2F802C5BFF"/>
<VERSION value="2811121640"/>
<PROFILE_NAME class="string" value="Test"/>
```

Parameter	Value	
MAC_ADDRESS	Valid MAC address of the device	If MAC address is not the MAC address of the device then config file is not used.
VERSION	DDMMYYHHMM example: 2811120928	If date/time stamp is not newer, then config file is not used.
PROFILE_NAME	The Name of the profile	

Some provisioning systems are not able to generate the MAC_ADDRESS or the VERSION parameters and therefore we changed the behaviour.

From release 84 the MAC_ADDRESS and VERSION parameters are optional. When available they are used, but can also be removed.

Feature is not available for binary provisioning within `chagall_profile_gen` (`gigaset_profile_gen`) tool.
